1. To install your new Corbin saddle, you're first going to have to remove the stock seat. Refer to your owner's manual if necessary.

2. Install the included pigtail. This is a one time installation that can stay on the bike even when you remove the saddle.

3. Included with your electric heated seat you will find a short wiring pigtail with built in fuse. Installation of this pigtail is simple and mounts directly to your battery.

4. Connect as follows:

- a. Disconnect negative lead from battery (*Figure 1*).
- b. Disconnect positive lead from battery (*Figure 2*) and reinstall along with red (fuse) lead from pigtail (*Figure 3*).
- c. Reconnect negative lead along with black lead of pigtail (*Figure 4*).
- d. Assure both terminals are tightened securely.

5. Bundle loose wiring and secure with the included zip tie (*Figure 5*). Do not tighten excessively or you may damage the wiring... just secure it in place for cleanliness.

6. Next, plug the pigtail into the seat wiring (*Figure 6*). Turn the ignition switch on and flip on the seat heater. If the heater switch illuminates, then your wiring is fine and you're ready to move on.

**NOTE:** Saddle features a digital timer to automatically shut down the heater after one-hour in case it is forgotten when parking the bike.

7. To install your Gunfighter Saddle, simply slide the saddle into place nose first to engage the tongue, lower the rear into place and push firmly on the passenger platform to latch (*Figure 7*).


